

CANOPY BOXES

A four sided aluminium box riveted at each corner with flanges turned in to the front and back edge. The fly screen is fitted on the front section with hinges and turn buttons and forms a perfect seal to all four sides. Canopy boxes are available in square or splayed sections according to window types. The fly screen is fully removable for cleaning and servicing.

CANOPY BOX

<u>How they work</u>	The canopy box has front and rear a flange, the rear flange is used to secure the box to either the existing window frame or any flat surface. The fly screen is hinged to the front flange making access for cleaning both window and screen easy. Once secured, the window will open into the box allowing ventilation, yet keeping flying insects out.
<u>Suitability</u>	This type of canopy box can be fitted over any UPVC, timber or metal casements and is ideal for mounting over louvers or horizontal and vertical centre pivot windows. Fibreglass mesh is fitted as standard, but stainless steel or aluminium mesh can be fitted where required.
<u>Removal</u>	The canopy box is usually a permanent fixture and cannot be easily removed.
<u>Maintenance</u>	The canopy box can be cleaned with warm, soapy water to remove grease or dirt. All meshes to the screens can also be washed in soapy water and dusty screens should be vacuumed or brushed clean.
<u>Technical</u>	Standard colours – White to BS9010 and brown to BS8017 The standard range of colours can be matched at extra cost. Fibre mesh – 18 x 14 weave, charcoal, ventilation 66% Fibre mesh – 20 x 20 weave, charcoal, ventilation 32% Stainless steel – 18 x 14 weave, charcoal, ventilation 66% Aluminium - 18 x 14 weave, charcoal, ventilation 66%
<u>Guarantee</u>	12 months on all workmanship under normal wear and tear.
